Frequently Asked Questions Regarding LBHOA Boat and Trailer Tags

1. When are tags on boats and trailers required?

Tags have been required since March 15, 2009. Boats or trailers without tags may be towed away at the owner's expense.

2. I have a registration number on my boat. Isn't that good enough?

No. We cannot easily identify the owner of a boat by the state registration number. The LBHOA tag will identify your boat to the HOA.

3. What kinds of boats require tags?

All motorized boats including personal watercraft require a tag.

4. Is there a fee for a tag?

No.

5. What if I only launch a boat and do not dock it at the marina?

You will still need a tag to launch a boat.

6. How do I get tags?

Fill out the tag application form from the website and mail it to the Legacy Bay HOA, 6035 Paradise Cove Drive, Mooresburg, TN 37811 with appropriate documentation.

7. How do I establish proof of ownership?

A government-issued registration document indicating a LBHOA property owner as the owner of the boat or trailer is required. In the absence of a registration document, a bill of sale indicating the LBHOA property owner as the purchaser of the boat or trailer will suffice.

8. My adult family member owns a boat. Can he use the Legacy Bay boat ramp, dock his boat or store his boat at Legacy Bay?

No, unless the family member lives with you at your current residence or is visiting Legacy Bay accompanied by you. If the family member is visiting Legacy Bay while accompanied by you, he will be able to get a temporary tag.

9. What if I have visitors who have a boat and trailer? Will they get temporary tags?

Yes. Temporary tags are available for accompanied visitors of LBHOA members who use our boat ramp, dock, or boat parking area. These temporary tags will be issued for the specific period of time your visitor is visiting you at Legacy Bay and will be void thereafter.

10. I know someone who has a boat and I would like to allow him to use our boat ramp or dock. Will he get a temporary tag?

No. Use of the boat ramp and the dock area is only for you and for those persons visiting you. If you are not accompanying the person, he may not use the ramp and dock area and no temporary tag will be issued. This person's boat or trailer without a tag will be towed at the owner's expense.

11. Can my visitors use LBHOA amenities in my absence if I give them permission?

No, you must accompany all guests who use Legacy Bay amenities or you must be present on Legacy Bay property while your visitors are using the amenities.

12. What if my tag is lost?

Notify the LBHOA immediately and a replacement tag will be sent to you.

13. What if I sell my boat/trailer?

Notify LBHOA and remove the LBHOA tag from your boat and/or trailer.

14. Can I dock more than one boat?

No. At present there is dock space for one boat per property owner.

15. What happens if I don't get a tag and my boat or trailer is towed away?

You will be billed for the expense of towing your boat or trailer and the facility storing your boat will bill you for storage fees.

16. This sounds like a lot of trouble to go to. Is it really necessary?

Yes. Unauthorized use of our facilities presents a safety and liability hazard to the community and adds to your cost of upkeep and repair.

Fill out and mail this form, along with the documents indicated below, to the address on the left.

- Since March 15, 2009, all boats and trailers using, stored at or docked in the Legacy Bay marina parking lot, dock area or marina must be identified with a Legacy Bay tag.
- Only those boats and trailers owned by property owners of Legacy Bay shall be allowed to receive tags.
- Boats and trailers without tags shall be subject to removal at the owner's expense.

Proof of Ownership Documentation:

Attach a copy of a state registration document showing your ownership of each of the boats and trailers you are requesting a tag for. If you do not have a state registration document attach a copy of a bill of sale for the item with the Legacy Bay property owner identified as the purchaser.

Tags will be issued only for boats and trailers that are owned by legally-deeded property owners of Legacy Bay. Boats and trailers owned by members of the immediate household of Legacy Bay property owners are eligible for tags only if those immediate household members reside at the same address as the legally-deeded property owner of Legacy Bay. Proof of residence is required for the boats and trailers of these immediate family members. A copy of their driver license or other government-issued document must be provided with this registration form.

Mail this registration form along with copies of your documentation for each boat and trailer to the Association at the above address.

I affirm that each of the boats and trailers identified above are owned by me as a Legacy Bay property owner or are owned by a member of my immediate household living with me. I understand that boats and trailers without proper tags may be removed from Legacy Bay property at the owner's expense.
